### **2023 Open Poetry Competition for Young People/ 2023 Open Short Story Competition for Young People**

#### **RULES FOR ENTRY**

1. **These two competitions are open to anyone living in a North Somerset postcode who is 14-18 years of age only.**
2. Entrants must be in full or part-time education at a school or college.
3. Entries must be typed (1.5 line spacing preferred), written in English and:
  - A. Poems must be no more than 40 lines in length (excluding title)
  - B. Short stories must be no longer than 500 words (excluding title)
4. Each entrant may only submit one short story or up to three poems.
5. Do not use offensive, discriminatory language, or language promoting hate speech or violence, in your poem. Doing so will lead to disqualification.
6. Your name, or any other identifying marks, should not be added to your poem/short story.
7. The poem/short story must be your own, original work and should not have won another competition or been previously published in print or online.
8. No changes will be permitted once work has been submitted
9. These competitions are not open to any person affiliated with Clevedon Literary Festival, partner organisations or their immediate relatives.
10. Entries not following these rules will be disqualified.
11. The judges' decision is final and no feedback will be given.
12. Keep your own copy of the work as entries cannot be returned.
13. Copyright is retained by the author.
14. Prize winners will be notified by email to your parent or teacher and Clevedon Literary Festival retains the right to publish prize winning entries for a period of 12 months from the date of that notification.
15. Prize winners will be invited to attend a prize-giving event in Clevedon in November 2023 (details to be confirmed).
16. Clevedon Literary Festival reserves the right to publish video footage, screenshot images and/or photos gathered from the prizegiving event on its website and social media platform accounts. You must inform us if you wish to opt out of this.

#### **HOW TO ENTER**

- a) Your entry should be submitted as an email attachment.
- b) The subject line must be:
  1. Poems - 'Poetry Competition - Young People 2023'
  2. Short story - 'Short Story Competition - Young People 2023'
- c) The body of the email should include your name, your age, a title for your poem/short story, your contact details (including the first part of your postcode for monitoring purposes), the school/college you attend, and an email address for your parent and/or teacher.
- d) If you are submitting an entry for the Poetry Competition and an entry for the Short Story Competition, you must send each one in a separate email.
- e) Send your email/s, with attachment/s, to:

  2. Short story: CLFstorycomp@gmail.com
- f) If it is impossible for you to submit your entry by email, you can post or deliver a hard copy of your poem/short story, with a separate piece of paper containing all of the information asked for in c) above, to Clevedon Literary Festival c/o Clevedon Community Centre, Princes Road, Clevedon BS21 7SZ
- g) If entry details are NOT completed as above, an entry may not be accepted.
